Kristel asked Sylvain if she would be depositing the three pay checks she has mailed her. Sylvain stated she didn't receive any. Kristel asked if she would like her to reissue them to be able to deposit, Sylvain stated she didn't want paid. Kristel stated this is why the ordinance is on the agenda for these unclaimed checks. Donsbach stated I believe we have discussed this and it was stated if you wanted to donate your pay you needed to deposit your check and then you can donate it back to the Village. Sylvain stated she never received any checks. Mayor asked her if she receives her utility bills at her address. Sylvain stated not always sometimes she has to call Kristel for the amounts.

Sylvain stated that is not true the comparisons is a broker. Mayor stated we will find out.


ADJOURNMENT:

Donsbach made a motion, seconded by Frantz, to adjourn.


