RESOLUTION OF INTENT TO
PROCEED WITH IMPROVEMENT
IN THE MATTER OF STATE ROUTE 65
LOW PRESSURE SANITARY SEWER EXTENSION,
VILLAGE OF GRAND RAPIDS, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO

WHEREAS, A Resolution of Necessity in the matter of construction, maintenance, and operation of a Low Pressure Sanitary Sewer system in Grand Rapids, Wood County, Ohio, was adopted by this Council by Resolution No. 2020-01 dated March 9, 2020; and

WHEREAS, Notices of tentative assessments were sent to the property owners, Objections to the estimated charges may be filed which will be heard by an Equalization Board hearing at a place and time to be determined; and

WHEREAS, This Council has determined to begin the bidding and construction phases of the project while completing the Equalization Board process; and


WHEREAS, Chad Hoffman, Village Administrator, recommends the Village of Grand Rapids Council proceed with the bidding of this project in order to receive loan monies being pursued; therefore be it

SECTION 1: That the Village Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids and enter into a contract or contracts for the State Route 65 Low Pressure Sanitary Sewer Extension in Grand Rapids, Wood County, Ohio as provided for in the Resolution of Necessity passed by this Council on March 9, 2020, in accordance with the plans, specifications and estimates for this improvement as previously approved by this Board; and be it further

SECTION 2: That the Council of the Village of Grand Rapids hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council, and that all deliberations of the Council and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22, Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3: That this Resolution is hereby declared an emergency measure. The reason for the emergency is that it is urgently necessary to complete this project because residences in the area are under orders from the Wood County Health District to comply with sanitary regulations, and therefore, shall go into immediate effect.
