MITIGATION PLAN ADOPTION RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE OF GRAND RAPIDS ADOPTING THE FEDERALLY APPROVED WOOD COUNTY HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN.

WHEREAS, the Village of Grand Rapids, Wood County, Ohio, recognize the threat that natural, human-caused, and technological hazards pose to people and property within Wood County; and

WHEREAS, Wood County has prepared a multi-hazard mitigation plan, hereby known as Wood County Hazard Mitigation Plan of 2024, in accordance with the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000; and

WHEREAS, the Wood County Hazard Mitigation Plan identifies mitigation goals and actions to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to people and property in Wood County from the impacts of future hazards and disasters; and

WHEREAS, the Wood County Emergency Management Agency received formal approval from the Ohio Emergency Management Agency (OEMA) and the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) for the Plan; and

WHEREAS, said Wood County Hazard Mitigation Plan is on file in the Wood County Emergency Management Agency;

WHEREAS, adoption by the Village of Grand Rapids demonstrates their commitment to the hazard mitigation and achieving the goals outlined in the WOOD COUNTY HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN of 2024.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE OF GRAND RAPIDS, COUNTY OF WOOD, STATE OF OHIO, that:

SECTION 1. In accordance with the Ohio Revised Code, the Village of Grand Rapids shall go on record as they adopt the final version of the WOOD COUNTY HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN of 2024 as approved by OEMA and FEMA.

SECTION 2: This resolution shall take effect at the earliest period by law.
