A RESOLUTION DETERMINING TO PROCEED TO SUBMIT TO THE ELECTORS OF THE VILLAGE OF GRAND RAPIDS THE QUESTION OF A RENEWAL OF A TAX IN EXCESS OF THE 10 MILL LIMITATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING 2.0 MILLS FOR THE GENERAL CONSTRUCTION, RECONSTRUCTION, RESURFACING, AND REPAIRS OF STREETS & BRIDGES IN THE VILLAGE OF GRAND RAPIDS


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GRAND RAPIDS, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That for the purpose of providing additional funds for the general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing, and repairs of streets and bridges in the Village of Grand Rapids, it is necessary to approve the renewal of a 2.0 mills tax on each dollar of tax valuation of the taxable property within the Village of Grand Rapids, Ohio, and that it is necessary to levy said tax outside of the limitations imposed by Section 2, Article XII, of the Ohio Constitution; and that said additional tax request shall be submitted to the electors of the Village of Grand Rapids at the general election to be held on the second Tuesday in November 2016; in order that said tax levy shall be placed on the tax duplicate effective January 1, 2017, and collected on and after January 1, 2018 and thereafter for a total of five (5) years.

SECTION 2. That the Fiscal Officer of the Village is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to proceed to the Auditor of the County and to the Director of the Wood County Board of Elections all as required by the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.
