**RESOLUTION ENCOURAGING THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO MAKE CHANGES TO THE TRAFFIC PATTERN AT THE INTERSECTION OF STATE ROUTE 65 AND STATE ROUTE 295**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE OF GRAND RAPIDS, COUNTY OF WOOD AND STATE OF OHIO:

WHEREAS, The Village of Grand Rapids Council recognizes the recent traffic accidents at the intersection of State Route 65 and State Route 295, and;

WHEREAS, Both routes are vital for citizens to travel into the Village of Grand Rapids;

WHEREAS, The Village of Grand Rapids Council has a duty to protect the safety of its residents, visitors and businesses in and around the village;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GRAND RAPIDS, WOOD COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1: That the Village of Grand Rapids encourages the Ohio Department of Transportation to place a four-way stop sign at the intersection of State Route 65 and State Route 295. Council believes by adding the stop signs and altering the traffic pattern, this will ensure the safety of its citizens, residents, visitors and business traffic attempting to access the Village of Grand Rapids, Wood County, Ohio.

SECTION 2: This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.
