AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE OF GRAND RAPIDS TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT AND BECOME A MEMBER OF LAKE ERIE WEST REGIONAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, Lake Erie West Regional Council (formerly the Toledo Metropolitan Area Council of Governments) is a voluntary association of political subdivisions in northwest Ohio and southeast Michigan; and,

WHEREAS, counties, cities, villages, townships, public school districts, public universities and colleges, special districts, and other political subdivisions that represent and serve the citizens of the Toledo metropolitan region of northwest Ohio and southeast Michigan have common opportunities, issues, and problems that transcend their individual jurisdictions; and,

WHEREAS, since 1968, Lake Erie West has fostered regional progress and served as a forum for assessing and acting on regional issues; and,

WHEREAS, Lake Erie West carries out responsibilities as the Metropolitan Planning Organization as well as the Areawide Water Quality Planning Agency for the region; and,

WHEREAS, the Village of Grand Rapids seeks to enter into an agreement and become a dues paying member of Lake Erie West Regional Council.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Village of Grand Rapids Council, a majority or more of all members thereof concurring as follows:

SECTION 1: The Village of Grand Rapids Council authorizes the Mayor to enter into an agreement with Lake Erie West. A copy of the agreement is attached as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2: That this Village of Grand Rapids Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Village of Grand Rapids Council, and that all deliberations of this Village of Grand Rapids Council which results in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION3: This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
