

Resolution No. **2026 - 10** Passed July 18, 2026

VILLAGE OF GRAND RAPIDS WOOD COUNTY, OHIO
RESOLUTION TO PROCEED WITH A BALLOT ISSUE SUBMITTING
THE QUESTION OF A TAX LEVY RENEWAL TO THE VOTERS OF THE
VILLAGE OF GRAND RAPIDS, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Whereas, the Council of the Village of Grand Rapids, Ohio, has passed Resolution 2026-06 certifying to the Wood County Auditor the necessity to levy a tax outside the ten-mill limitation, and

Whereas, the Wood County Auditor issued a Certificate of Estimated Property Tax Revenue on June 18th 2026.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Village of Grand Rapids, Ohio, that

SECTION 1. The Village of Grand Rapids, Ohio, shall proceed with a ballot issue submitting to the voters of the Village of Grand Rapids, Ohio, and a tax renewal for the purpose of Street construction and reconstruction expenses.

SECTION 2. The tax renewal rate shall be two (2) mills for each one dollar in tax valuation, and shall be levied for tax years 2027, 2028, 2029, 2030 and 2031.

SECTION 3. The Wood County Auditor has estimated the property tax revenue produced by the stated millage to be \$32,368 the total tax valuation of the Village used in calculating the estimated property tax millage rate is \$23,991.325.

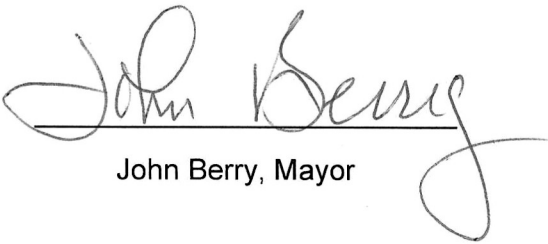
SECTION 4. The Fiscal Officer is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to the Wood County Board of Elections in order that said Board of Elections may make the necessary arrangements for the submission of such question to the electors of the Village of Grand Rapids, as provided by law, at the general election to be held November 3rd 2026.

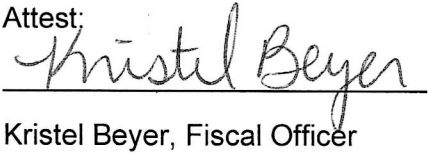
SECTION 5. This measure is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the Village and its residents. The reason for such emergency is that this resolution must be submitted to the Wood County Board of Elections not later than August 5th 2026, in order for the ballot measure to be properly placed on the ballot November 3rd 2026 General Election. The money that will be raised by passage of the ballot measure is necessary for the Street Construction and Reconstruction for the Village.

SECTION 6. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any other committees that results in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 7. This Resolution should take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.
