## Grant Criteria for the Village of Grand Rapids, Ohio ARPA funds

Grand Rapids' Village Council has allocated \$67,500 of federal ARPA funds to be used by non-profit organizations who serve Grand Rapids residents who were impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic. The criteria to be used to award grants are:

- 1. Grants are to be made to 501(c)(3) organizations located in the 43522-zip code-area who serve Grand Rapids residents. If the organization is not a 501(c)(3), a sponsoring organization must be used; they must have a 501(c)(3) designation.
- 2. ARPA Rescue funds are for those non-profit organizations whose clientele substantially include *individuals* who are Grand Rapids residents and have been most negatively impacted by COVID (e.g. lower income, those with food insecurity, unemployed)
- 3. Grants are to be made to eligible organizations as listed above who were in operation in the time period from the official start of the COVID pandemic lock-down (March 15, 2020) through the end of calendar year 2021.
- 4. Maximum grant is \$7,500 (not guaranteed)
- 5. A completed application and supporting documents must be submitted together in order to be considered for funding.
- 6. Grant applications must include the following supporting documents:
  - a. Board Member and Officer List
  - b. Proof of organization (or sponsoring organization) 501(c)(3) status
  - c. Financial Statements for 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022 and 2023
  - d. Budgets for 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022 and 2023
  - e. Summary of persons served during the Pandemic dates listed above
  - f. Narrative of programs and funding that were impacted by the Pandemic
  - g. Narrative of long-term plans for viability post-pandemic
- 7. The time period for spending awarded funds will be a rolling 12-month period from the date of the award but no later than December 31, 2025. **Deadline to apply is March 29, 2024**.
